

RESOLUTION 2014-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AMENDING ITS SCHEDULE OF RATES, FEES, RENTALS AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF THE DISTRICT'S PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Sections 190.011 and 190.035, Florida Statutes authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the Gateway Services Community Development District, hereinafter referred to as District, to prescribe, fix, establish and collect rates, fees, rentals or other charges for the facilities and services provided by the District, including parks and recreational facilities; and,

WHEREAS, Section 190.035, Florida Statutes requires the District to conduct a public hearing and to advertise the same for the purpose of hearing comments and objections to the proposed adoption of rates, fees, rentals and charges for the use of the District's parks and recreational facilities, the expenses of operation and maintenance of said facilities and the efficient and effective operations of the District's parks and recreational facilities and assets; and,


WHEREAS, the District conducted a duly and properly noticed public hearing on October 3, 2013 for the purpose of hearing public comment and objections to proposed revised rates, fees, rentals and charges for the use of the District's parks and recreational facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA;

1. The Gateway Services Community Development District hereby adopts the revised rates, fees, rentals and charges for the use of the District's parks and recreational facilities as outlined in the document attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

2. This Resolution and the revised rates, fees, rentals and charges for the use of the District's parks and recreational facilities shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

\*\*Leagues typically have two or three seasons per year and each season will have a charge.

\*\*\*Leagues are responsible for managing the collection of non-resident fees. Non-Resident fees are annual based January to January. Leagues must provide GSCDD with a league roster listing (at a minimum) all players names and address. Addresses will be verified by GSCDD. Note: Youth rosters are protected under the Sunshine

Laws and may not be distributed.

\*All league fees are due 30 days prior to the start of any regular season.

**Basic Park Rules**

1. Parks are open for public use during posted hours.
2. You must have your reservation copy with you during the event.
3. Conduct no activity which might damage park facilities.
4. Please use only designated parking areas.
5. Obvious violations of expected attendance stated on reservation subjects group to loss of reservation.
6. No equipment may be moved or relocated without written permission from the GSCDD Parks & Recreation Leader.
7. A damage-clean up assessment may be applied to anyone reserving field usage, at the GSCDD's discretion.
8. Prioritization of field usage is schedule driven.
