

Gateway Services Community Development District News

At the Supervisors of Gateway Services Community Development District meeting, the Supervisors approved the budgeted utilities expenditure of \$70,000 for replacement and repair of the District Fire Hydrants.

There was discussion regarding switching internet and phone service provider from Comcast to Century Link. After the discussion a motion was made and approved to see if there was a possibility to renegotiate with Comcast. The staff will return to a future District meeting with more information.

The Board approved expenditures for Downspout Initiative, plant replacement, pond planting and Preserve Area Maintenance for Pelican Preserve.

A new board Resolution (2018-04) with updated golf cart regulations was approved by the Board. It contains many of the regulations proposed by the PPAC/SSWG with the exception of where golf carts should be operated on the main roads. The resolution states that "Golf carts should be operated and driven in the undesignated four (4) foot outside travel land/shoulder".

The District Manager reported that repairs for Lake 83 in Magnolia Park should begin next week. He is also working on obtaining money from FEMA via the State.

The Board of Supervisors approved the conveyance and turnover of the lakes and drainage, both primary and secondary, in the Hampton Park Community

There was a discussion concerning those permits not transferred to the Operation Entity due to the deadline by South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD). The District plans to meet with SFWMD and come up with a resolution.
