CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS

1. This permit, complete with all conditions and maps, shall be in the possession of the Trapper or Designated Agent during the take of alligators under this permit.
2. Alligators shall only be removed at the request and direction of the following designated personnel for **GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (239-561-1313, office)**:
 - a. Chris Shoemaker, District Supervisor (239-284-0350, cell; 239-561-1313, office) (chris.shoemaker@gatewaydistrict.org)
 - b. Elle Harris, Natural Resource Supervisor (239-898-6312, cell; 239-561-1313, office) (elle.harris@gatewaydistrict.org)
3. You must contact one of the listed **GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT** personnel prior to working any Nuisance Alligator Harvest Permit received from SNAP that falls within this area.
4. Access to **GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT** managed waters shall be accessed through Lake Access Easements.
5. No alligators shall be harvested from sovereign waters under the permit unless those sovereign waters are specifically listed on the permit.
6. This permit shall be revoked or reassigned should the Contracted Nuisance Alligator Trapper under contract with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission resigns or upon the contract expiring or being terminated.
